- A. Stealing from humans.
  - 1. Depriving a person of property is stealing.
    - a. Property as necessity. 1 Timothy 6:6-8; Deuteronomy 24:6-13
    - b. Property as a right. Exodus 20:17
    - c. Property as a trust. Psalm 24:1
  - 2. Depriving a person of liberty is stealing.
    - a. Persons as God's servants. Leviticus 25:55
    - b. Denying freedom to be what God intended. Deuteronomy 24:7
  - 3. Depriving a person of dignity is stealing.
    - a. Destroying a reputation.
    - b. Degrading a name. Acts 19:25-27
    - c. Denying a person justice. Isaiah 10:1-3
  - 4. Depriving a person of opportunity is stealing.
    - a. The businessman's opportunity to do business. Titus 2:10
    - b. The government's opportunity to govern. Luke 20:25
    - c. The poor man's opportunity to survive. Deuteronomy 24:14-15
    - d. The suffering man's opportunity to recover. Deuteronomy 15:7-11
- B. Stealing from God.
  - 1. Contradictory behavior robs God of credibility. Jeremiah 7:1-11; Luke 19:45-46
    - a. Powerful profession.
- b. Pitiful performance.
  - 2. Refusing tithes and offerings robs God of honor. Malachi 3:8-10
    - a. Tithes and offerings belong to the Lord. Leviticus 27:30
      - i. The annual tithe. Deuteronomy 14:22-27
      - ii. The three yearly tithe. Deuteronomy 12:6
      - iii. The offerings for sacrifice. Deuteronomy 12:6
      - iv. The special offerings. Exodus 35:4
    - b. Failing to give is keeping what is God's.
      - i. First rate stinginess. Nehemiah 13:10; Ecclesiastes 5:13
      - ii. Second rate sacrifice. Malachi 1:6-14
      - iii. Third rate motives. Matthew 6:2; Acts 5:1-11
