I. The Cry of My Heart.

Let my cry come before you, O Lord; give me understanding. May my supplication come before you; deliver me according to your promise. Psalm 119:169 & 170

- A. Can hearts cry? Oh yes!
 - 1. Who hasn't tossed and turned all night worrying about a child who is passed her curfew or a marriage on the rocks?
 - 2. Who has not wept their way through a terrible trouble that has been allowed to touch those we love?
 - 3. Or what about permitted pain, job loss, grief when a friend doesn't know the Lord or does but is off track?
 - 4. Who in your world is in trouble with the law or addictions, depression or straying from their faith like a lost sheep?
 - 5. Who does not know "the cry of the heart?" David wrote: My soul is weary with sorrow; strengthen me according to Your Word. Psalm 119:28
- B. Get me back on track.

I have strayed like a lost sheep seek your servant. Psalm 119:176

C. Help me to use the pain.

It was good for me to be afflicted so that I may learn your decrees. Psalm 119:71

- D. I need to practice the precepts.
 - 1. This has been my practice. I obey your precepts. Psalm 119:56
 - 2. Practicing obedience sounds sort of forensic. Shouldn't I want to work on my relationship with God rather than have to? Shouldn't it be spontaneous?

II. To Trust and Obey.

I run in the path of your commands for you have set my feet free. Psalm 119:32

A. Seek me.

I have strayed like a lost sheep. Seek your servant for I have not forgotten your commands. Psalm 119:176

B. Save me.

Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I obey your word. Psalm 119:67

C. Steady me.

May your hand be ready to help me, for I have chosen your precepts. Psalm 119:173

III. Shepherd Passages.

The Lord is my Shepherd I shall not be in want. Psalm 23:1(also Luke 15 & John 10)

- A. The sound of His voice. John 10:1-16
 - 1. Sure: All your Words are true. Psalm 119:160 & John 8:31
 - 2. Safe: Great peace have they that love your law and nothing can make them stumble. Psalm 119:165
- B. What does His voice sound like?
 - 1. Word: Give me understanding according to your word. Psalm 119:169
 - 2. Promises: Deliver me according to your promise. Psalm 119:170
 - 3. Decrees: Your degrees are the theme of my song wherever I lodge. Psalm 119:54
 - 4. Commands: Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119:105
 - 5. Precepts: The precepts are right giving joy to the heart. Psalm 19:8
 - 6. Laws: Your laws sustain me. Psalm 119:175
